In the Name of God Amen: Know ye that I Jane Dunne of St Earth In the County of Cornwall Widow being of perfect memory praised bee god Doe make this my last will and Testament in manner and forme following:

Imp[ri]mis I bequeath my Soule to Almghty God yt gave itt and trust in his mercy for Salvation: And my Body I bequeath to decent and Christian Buriall in the Earth from whence itt came @: Item I give and bequeath to my eldest Sonne John Dunne one shilling when hee shall come to demand itt

Item I give and bequeath to my second Sonne Robert one shilling Item I give and bequeath to my youngest Sonne Pascow one shilling All the rest of my goods and Chattles Aswell w[ith]in doors as w[ith]out I give and bequeath in hand to my Daughter Christian whome I make my full and whole Executrix Provided that in Considiration here of ffrancis Richards and the said Christian my Daughter and wife to the said ffrancis offere mee A competent and nessesary maintenance from this time to the day of my Death

More itt is my will also that the Children of my Daughter begotten Or here after to begotten on her body enjoye all the Right terme and estate after her decease in the p@@sses afores[ai]d This is my last will and Testament Wittness my hand and seale yeoxen this Ninth day of July In the yeare of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ One Thousand Six Hundred Sixty and Eight
